



COVID-19 Pandemic Precautions

From the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, KCNSC has been proactively taking precautionary measures to protect the health and safety of our employees, visitors and suppliers. We've established numerous administrative and engineering controls aimed at minimizing potential virus exposure or spread, such as stringent social distancing methods, the availability of personal protection equipment and temperature screenings at entrances. These actions have positioned us to continue working toward a return to a new normal operations in a COVID-19 environment.

At this time, only mission-critical visits are allowed at KCNSC sites. Please work with your host to determine if a site visit is permissible. If your visit is approved, you will be required to review COVID-19 safety precautions training when you arrive. All precautionary measures at the KCNSC are closely aligned with guidance promulgated by the CDC, and all applicable federal, state, and local requirements regarding COVID-19.

As a further precaution, **we require face masks/coverings** when entering our facility and conduct temperature checks for all individuals entering the facility. Individuals with a temperature of a 100.4 degrees or higher may not enter. Moreover, contractors and visitors to any KCNSC site who meet any of the criteria below are not allowed on the premises until 14 days after the last possible exposure has lapsed and the individual is symptom-free. Updated travel restrictions can be reviewed at the front desk upon arrival and prior to entering the facility. **Please be aware changes may occur in guidance prior to your visit. Please stay in contact with your host.**

- Within the last 14 days, have traveled internationally to any countries specifically listed in the CDC tables as HIGH risk or greater. The list of countries is available at <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers/map-and-travel-notices.html> and Security;
- Been exposed to the COVID-19 virus; or
- Have COVID-19 virus symptoms (fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting and/or diarrhea cough.)

In addition to standard year-round cleaning practices for communicable diseases, such as the annual flu, increased cleaning has been added as a precaution for COVID-19 concerns. Special attention is given to cleaning of touch points (doors, railings, turnstiles, keypads etc.) and high traffic areas throughout our facilities.

KCNSC continues to closely monitoring the situation involving the COVID-19 virus. We will maintain our safety practices and continue social distancing activities until the safety/medical guidance from the appropriate agencies remove those recommendations. Thank you for your understanding during this challenging time.

PARKING

SECURITY

Please be aware that all visitors **must** be U.S. Citizens and present valid photo ID. If visitors are from states that are not compliant with the Real ID Act, they must present a second form of ID: military ID, a U.S. passport or other photo ID issued by a local or state government entity. If second form of ID is not available, the individual must either be denied entry or escorted by someone at all times. More information can be found at:

To ensure compliance with Personal Identity Verification (PIV) implementation, all uncleared visitors are required to provide their SSN prior to accessing the KCNSC facility. If unable to provide a SSN, visitors will be provided a one-day access badge. In this case, future access will be denied until their SSN is provided.

Please note that video, image and audio recording is NOT allowed at the Kansas City National Security Campus without Security approval. A limited number of cell phone lockers are available.
